

Selva Escondida

Directions from Multi-Plaza Mall, Escazu, San Jose, Costa Rica

Note: if you're driving from the airport, ask the rental car company how to drive to Dominical. It's a bit confusing to drive from the airport to Escazu, where our directions start. Total drive time is usually 2 hrs 40 mins. Welcome to Costa Rica!

1. **Take Highway 27** towards the Pacific Ocean (about 53 km or 45 minutes)
 - Drive from San José go to Escazu, pass toll booth @ 320 colones
 - Continue to San Rafael, pass toll booth @ 490 colones
 - Continue to Atenas & Orotina, pass toll booth @ 640 colones
 - Continue to Ponzo & Caldera, pass toll booth @ 480 colones and **then immediately exit to the right**, do the round about and continue on Highway 34.
2. **Take Highway 34** towards Jaco & Quepos (97 km or 90 minutes)
 - It will take 30 minutes to get to Jaco, then continue straight to Quepos
 - You will pass a village called Parrita where you'll need to slow down due to pedestrian traffic, just continue straight
 - Then you will pass a couple of long roads between rows of palm trees before arriving to Quepos area – keep going straight.
3. From **Quepos to Dominical** (44 km or 20 minutes)
 - 2 km before reaching Quepos, you will see a sign to Playa Dominical 44km
 - You will pass a police check-point just before Dominical.
 - After crossing the bridge, Dominical is immediately to the right. It's not well marked. Dominical has places to eat and a great beach.
4. From **Dominical to the Farm** (10 km or 15 minutes)
 - Once passed Dominical, continue on the same road for 10 minutes
 - You will pass 152km marker sign on the right side of the road
 - As soon as you see it, take the next left onto the dirt road. There will be a couple of signs: Jolly Rogers, Costa Verde, etc... (Cuna Del Angel is on the opposite side of the road from this turn.)
 - Drive 2km up hill, pass Jolly Rogers
 - Look for a black painted gate with 3 statues in front on your right. Palm trees line the driveway beyond the gate.
 - You'll need to open the gate. Please close it behind you every time. If you're unable to open the gate, please contact Vin at +506-8510-5801. Vin only speaks Spanish. If you wanted to say "Hi. My name is John. I'm at the gate, but it's locked. Please help me." Then in Spanish, you would say "Hola. Mi nombre es Juan. Estoy en el portón, pero está cerrada. Por favor, ayúdame."
